The American Society of Highway Engineers (ASHE) is proud to honor individuals that have made significant contributions to ASHE and the highway industry each year. The National Board requests that each Section/Region give sincere consideration to selecting nominees for each of the awards listed below.

Robert E. Pearson/Person of the Year Award:

The Pearson Award is given to an individual who has made notable and significant contributions to the transportation industry. The contributions should have a statewide or broader impact and involve paid and personal time and efforts, and participation in transportation-related societies or organizations. The recipient need not be a member of ASHE.

Young Member of the Year Award:

This award has been established to recognize young ASHE members who have made outstanding contributions to ASHE, the highway/transportation industry, and their communities during the early years of their careers.

Member of the Year Award:

This award is given to a member who has made notable achievements with ASHE within the past year, who has had a significant positive impact on ASHE, and who has earned a high level of respect with his or her peers.

Lifetime Achievement Award:

This award was established to recognize an ASHE member who has supported the organization in an exemplary manner throughout his or her career. The individual should have had a long-term positive impact on the Society.
