



HOW TO START A NEW SECTION





Identify a core group of 5 to 10 people interested in improving the transportation industry in your area. –Ideas to promote:

- Ability to network with industry leaders
- Chance to build a stronger relationship with target clients
- Forum to network with peers and learn what's new!



STEP 2 Set up a complimentary luncheon meeting.

A member of our National Board will visit your group and discuss the benefits of becoming an ASHE Section.

Have an attendee sign in sheet for contact information.

- -Ideas for locations:
 - Your office's conference room
 - Nearby restaurant
 - Meeting space (hotel, event center, etc)





Contact potential members and ask them to complete an application for membership. You will need a minimum of 35 people to start your Section (50 preferred).

-Ideas for More Members:

- Plan an event with industry leaders to present
- Social/Mixers





Identify and record your first-year officers and board members.

Draft by-laws. A template will be forwarded to you by ASHE National.





Host a charter meeting.

The ASHE National President will swear in officers and present the Charter certificate.

-Ideas for Charter Event:

• Plan for new board and make appealing to even more new members (industry leaders or networking opportunity)
