At-Large Membership Guidelines

The American Society of Highway Engineers has nine Regions which cover all 50 states. There are ASHE Regions within the United States that do not have a Director because there are no Sections in the Region. The At-Large Membership gives someone who lives and works in these areas the ability to join ASHE. The cost of an At-Large Membership is \$50.00 annually. The At-Large Member agrees to join any Section that is chartered within 50 miles of their residence. In the meantime, the National Membership Committee will route the applicant to the nearest ASHE Section, regardless of distance. This will promote dialogue and engagement with the member and the host section.

All At-Large Members of the American Society of Highway Engineers receive a Membership Certificate and Lapel Pin, as well as a copy of the SCANNER magazine every quarter. They are encouraged to attend any Section's Lunch/Dinner Meetings, Regional Technical Seminars, and the National Conference at the member rate.

The mission of ASHE is to provide a forum for members and partners of the highway industry. The At-Large Membership opens this forum to all highway industry partners within the United States. This national forum helps our membership approach a solution to common concerns that confront the highway industry.
